Report on project owners

1. Purpose of the report

The purpose of the report is to gain information about project owners who have sought to find funding through the crowdfunding platform.

2. Area of the report

The report shall provide information on the project owners who have submitted a project for funding. One reporting line shall be provided for each project owner for each project.

3. Reporting of data

Each project owner with the same project identifier is indicated as one line in the report.

4. Structure of the reporting rows

- 1) project identifier;
- 2) project owner identifier.

5. Explanation of the report row structure

1) Project identifier

The unique identifier assigned to the project is indicated here. According to the principle of Article 3 of Delegated Regulation (EU) 2022/2119, the unique identifier consists of the crowdfunding service provider's LEI code and eight unique numbers assigned to the crowdfunding offer by the crowdfunding service provider. The project identifier must match the same project identifier that was provided in the report on crowdfunding offer projects and in the report on investors.

2) Project owner identifier

The code used to identify each specific project owner is indicated here.

"Project owner" means any natural or legal person who seeks funding through a crowdfunding platform. If the project owner is a legal entity, its LEI code (*Legal Entity Identifier code*) is indicated here. If the project owner is a natural person, the identifier provided for in Article 6 of Commission Delegated Regulation (EU) 2017/590 is used to identify person, which consists of the ISO 3166-1 alpha-2 code (two-letter country code) of the person's nationality, followed by the national customer identifier based on the person's nationality in accordance with Annex II of the Regulation.
